Abuse and Effects of Oxycodone Addiction



When you abuse oxycodone, you may chew the tablets or you may crush them and snort them. Some people mix the tablet into a solution and inject it, or they smoke it by using tin foil. The main reason why people take the drug in this way is because they override the time-release function in the pill and it floods the brain with the drug. This engages your neurotransmitters which then trigger a euphoric high. This is very similar to what heroin or opium does. Since the year 2010, it has been manufactured in crush-proof tablets that cannot be injected or snorted, but either way, it's still possible to abuse the drug. Some of the symptoms of abuse include:

- Sweating
- Dry mouth
- Slowed breathing
- Dry mouth
- Headaches
- Constricted pupils
- Itching
- And more

Signs of an Oxycodone Addiction

One of the first [signs of an oxycodone addiction](#) is tolerance. You may find that you need more of the drug to feel the desired effect. Someone who is given the drug may become more dependent on the drug because chemical changes happen in the brain after prolonged use. This may cause you to develop withdrawal symptoms. 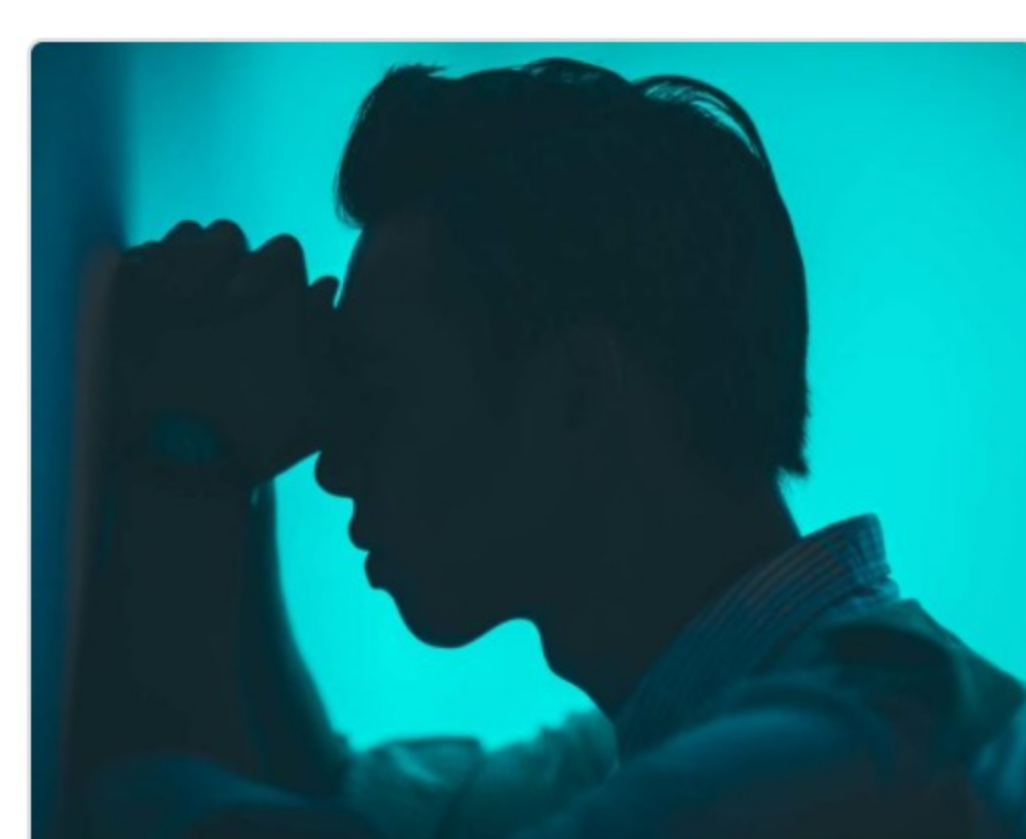
Treatment for an Oxycodone Addiction

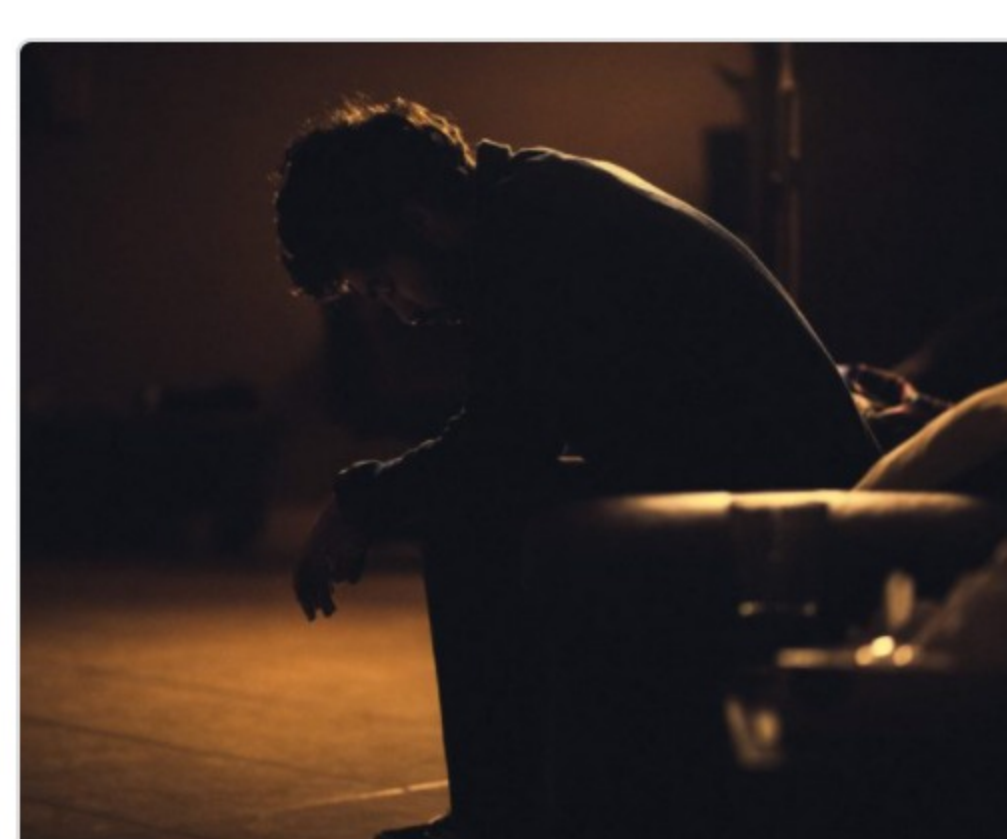


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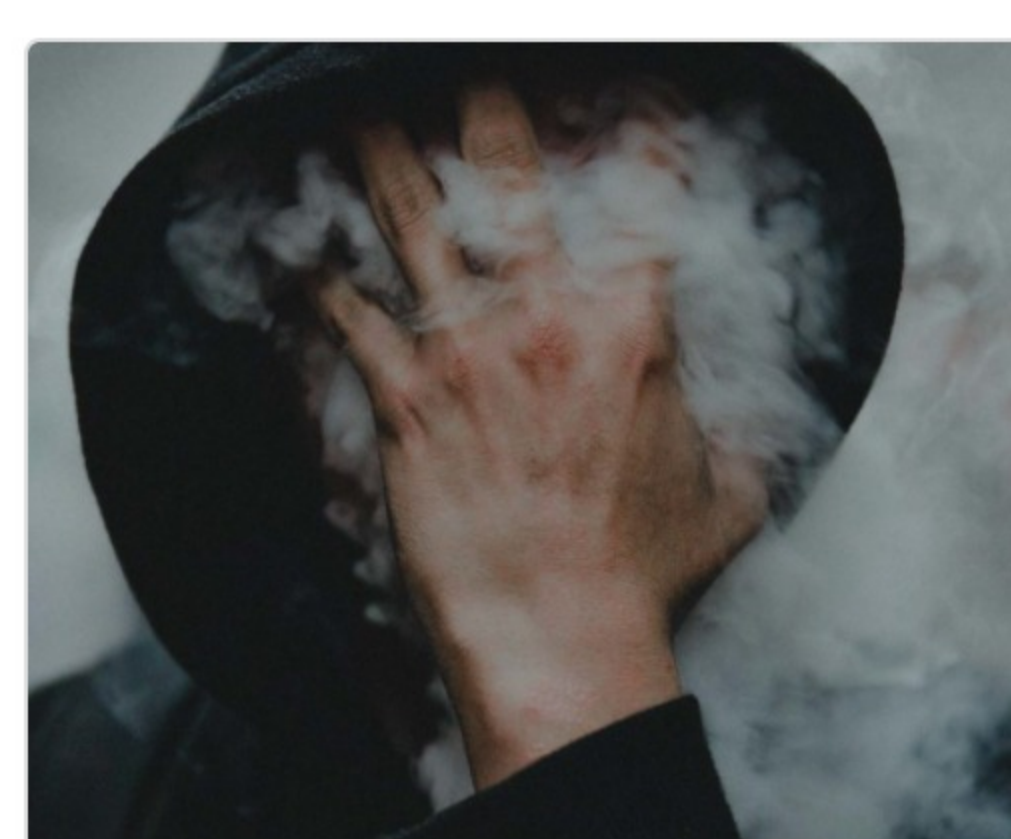
